photography challenge based around the theme of anti-corruption.

Theme: Corruption through my eyes

Photo specifications

Submit an original photo based on the theme of Corruption through My Eyes.

Please make sure the submitted photos follow the following specifications:

Uploaded Photos must be a minimum 1024 px longest side at 72 dpi

Uploaded Photos must be saved in RGB/sRGB colour gamut/mode

Uploaded Photos must be saved as JPEG, no less than compression 7 (medium)

o Files for upload must be no larger than 1.5 MB

Original files (camera jpeg or camera RAW if available) of winning photographs need to be sent to Corruption Watch for best possible reproduction. You will be notified accordingly.

Each photograph must include detailed caption information. All caption information must be submitted in the body of the e-mail and not on the photograph itself.

Participants must submit a short biography (150 words) as well as a high resolution picture of themselves.

All entries must be the work of the entrant and must not have been published or awarded with a prize in any

other photographic competition before.

It is the responsibility of each entrant to ensure that any images they submit have been taken with the

consent of the subject and do not infringe privacy rights, copyrights or any other rights of any person.

Photographs of each entry must be authentic, must be the photographer's original work and must not be

composed or image-processed (Adobe Photoshop, Adobe Freehand, GIMP etc.) work.
